Job Description:

The duties of this job include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Safely operate and maintain Company owned, leased, or rented heavy equipment including track dozers, excavators, mini-excavators, rubber tire loaders, skid steer loaders, compactors, service trucks for Morven Construction and other Customers.
- 2. Generate daily equipment rental sheets for Company invoicing.
- Complete daily equipment and vehicle checklists by inspecting equipment for fluid levels, leaks, safety equipment, undercarriage, and tire conditions. Report issues to Company Maintenance Coordinator.
- 4. Maintain valid Ontario G driver's license and insurable abstract.
- 5. Promote a safe working environment by participating in tailgate/safety meetings; identification of hazards; and ensure proper use of PPE.
- 6. This position may also include occasional physically demanding labor work including hand shoveling, raking, lifting, and carrying of materials (up to 50 lbs.), safe operation of hand tools and operation of compaction equipment. Work may include clean-up, general construction, layout, sewer and watermain installation, traffic control and landscaping.
