

Site Supervisor

Job Description:

The duties of this job include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. The Site Supervisor is responsible for organizing and coordinating site activities and supervising crews, to complete the project on schedule and within budget.
- 2. Supervise crews and projects, with a hands-on approach.
- 3. Maintain timelines, scheduling, planning, and coordination of scheduled activities.
- 4. Able to effectively communicate and interact with engineers, coordinators, superintendents, surveyors, sub-trades, and management.
- 5. Able to conduct tailgate/safety meetings; identify control and hazards; ensure proper use of PPE; conduct inspections.
- 6. Excellent time-management, organizational, and strong leadership skills
- 7. Able to adapt to changes and flexibility; ability to prioritize work schedule.
- 8. Responsible for organizing crews and equipment for the project.
- 9. Promote and maintain a safe work environment.
- 10. Able to read/interpret drawings, plans, blueprints, and contract documents; with a strong understanding of specifications, scope of work, and time lines.
- 11. Accomplishes work requirements by orienting, training, assigning, scheduling, and coaching employees; and supervising sub-contractors.
- 12. Inspecting work in progress to ensure that work conforms to specifications.
- 13. Support maintenance of accurate As-Built drawings
- 14. Generating daily work sheets with costs and recording quantities
- 15. Conducting daily tailgate meetings
- 16. Attending and participating in on-site meetings
- 17. Following and performing safe work practices and procedures through H&S policies and plans
- 18. Coordinating and supervising all construction activities
- 19. Directing workers on daily tasks
- 20. Tracking costs associated with work and daily review with project budget.
- 21. Problem solving site issues and minimizing construction delays and claims.
- 22. Daily planning of project tasks to ensure project work adheres to schedule.
- 23. Maintaining and completing required documentation.
